

HERITAGE MUSEUM OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY Scholarship Requirements

- 1) A \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified graduating high school senior who resides in Montgomery County based on the following criteria:
 - a) Candidate must be active in at least one civic or educational organization.
 - b) Candidate must have at least a 2.5 GPA (4.0 scale) and be in good standing with their high schools.
 - c) Candidate must be a citizen of the United States.
 - d) Candidate must plan to attend an accredited institute of higher learning within Texas.
 - e) Candidate must plan to enroll as a full-time student and pursue a **two or four**-year degree.
 - f) After a brief orientation meeting, the scholarship recipient must serve as a Museum Intern for a minimum of 10 volunteer hours at the Heritage Museum of Montgomery County during the summer following high school graduation.
 - g) Finalists must be willing to participate in an interview with the Scholarship Committee of the Museum, if asked.

- 2) Scholarship award must be used for tuition, books, and related course materials.

- 3) All scholarship monies (\$1,000.00) will be paid directly to the institute of higher learning at which the recipient enrolls and subsequently attends. (The Museum Director must sign off on the completion of the summer intern hours before the payment can be forwarded.)

- 1) Complete the attached two-page application form.
- 2) Organize your application in a folder to turn in or mail in the following order:
 - a) A blank sheet of paper with your name, high school, and the name of your counselor or contact person at your school.
 - b) An original typed essay of at least 200 and not more than 500 words on **one** of the following topics:
 - *A person who has been my mentor and how they have influenced me.*
 - *Why I selected my field of study and what I hope to accomplish once I complete it.*
 - c) The completed enclosed application form.
 - d) One letter of reference from a club sponsor, coach, teacher, or guidance counselor, or a person from a source outside of the high school system that is not related to you.
 - e) An official high school transcript.
- 3) If you have received any press coverage or recognition throughout your high school career, you may include that as the last page or pages of your folder. Send only copies.
